Dear Families of Nine Acres,

I would like to start this newsletter with very mixed emotions as we say a fond farewell to our Year 6 pupils as they leave us to begin their journey to Secondary School. Next week would have been the week they spent at their new school and I know many have already been in touch and discussed their plans for transition. They truly are a wonderful group of pupils, great friends to each other, dedicated to their learning and great children to teach. Their chosen Secondary School is very lucky! I know they will take the Nine Acres badge with them and show everybody their excellence in all they do.

On Monday 6th July, we will be holding our normal transition as all the children move up into their new Year group. Your child should come to school as normal (indicated in their letter - please note starting and finishing times below) and we will do the rest in school. The children will remain like this until the end of the term so they really get to settle in and begin their new curriculum. The staff have been very busy planning for the children so it is vital that when the school is open to your child they attend everyday. This is formal learning time now. Next week, we welcome back to school our Year 3 and Year 4 pupils. We can't wait to see them!

As the school is now fully open, the majority of children have returned and the staffing team are all leading formal learning within the pods, we are unable to provide the level of detail with the home learning packs. For those pupils who remain at home you will receive a final email of a list of websites next week, to access over the last few weeks and into the summer holidays to support your child at home. Please do keep in contact with us.

It is EYFS Sport's Day on Thursday. Although we are not able to have our families join us, we are now able to facilitate the event being filmed so we hope this will be available to parents as a DVD at a later date to share with your child. Don't forget they need sun cream applied, hat, water bottle and snack for the day!

It is really important that parents help us reinforce the expectations from the Government. We ask that you do not gather at the school gate or within the playground once you have dropped off your child. I know its lovely to have a good catch up but to help us stay open as a school we must ask you to leave the site as promptly as possible.
