



Year 5 - Spring Term 2 2024


Science

This term we will be studying animals and living things. We will be comparing the life cycle of animals, plants and humans and then representing how we can classify these animals on a dichotomous key.



Geography

- This term we will be studying 'Rivers and Biomes'
- We will be taking a field trip down to the River Medina, explore the route maps and then look at different biomes on the Isle of Wight and then around the world.



Music
