



Swimming and Water Safety at Nine Acres Primary School.

During Year Three, children are provided with weekly swimming lessons for the whole of the summer term by a qualified swimming instructor. The instructor monitors and assesses the children's progress and reports on the following National Curriculum outcomes:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

The outcomes for the academic year 2017-18 are as follows:

% of children who could confidently swim at least 25 metres.	% of children who would use a range of strokes effectively.	Perform safe self-rescue, including: Stop and think, stay together, float, call 999, know the dangers of water locally and nationally and know how and when to use appropriate survival and self-rescue skills if they fall in by accident or get into difficulty.
64% (28 children)	64% (28 children)	79% (35 children)

Children who do not reach the expected requirement by the end of the year will be provided with additional support to achieve this by the end of Year Six.
