

Dear Families,

It was lovely to see parents at the Year 4 Open Maths Morning! Thank you for taking the time to pop in and help your child with their maths. We will be holding more events like this throughout the year so please keep an eye on the newsletter and curriculum leaflets.

Nine Acres has been abuzz today with the excitement of the children meeting and working with a range of authors and illustrators from across the country. This morning, Paul Lyalls had Years 1-6 in side-splitting laughter at his poetry with topics ranging from bananas and rulers to Ikea! The talented island writers Peta Rainford and Kathryn Rossati were also both in before lunch — Peta worked with EYFS & Year 2 and Kathryn with some of our older pupils. This afternoon, our Year 3 children have worked with Jane Porter to produce their own illustrated mini-books whilst Years 4-6 were in the hall enraptured by Matt Brown and his books such as 'Killer Vending Machines Wrecked my Lunch'! It has been lovely to see the children so inspired about their writing — wet play at lunch time was spent with many children creating poetry and working on stories inspired by ideas from their workshops. This is the 4th year of running this event here at the school and we are so grateful to the organisers of the Isle of Wight Literary Festival for organising these experiences for our children. If your child would like a signed book from one of our authors, we have secured some special deals and will be placing another order at the end of next week — any interested children will be able to get an order form from their class teachers on Monday. Thank you to Mrs Tingle for once again organising such a privileged event at the school.

We are enjoying touring lots of new families for our EYFS intake 2020. Please do let people know about Nine Acres. Our next event is on **Wednesday 16th October at 1:30pm** for families to join us and see us in action.




