This half term children will learn about the concepts of symbols. We will consider why symbols are important to our life and which symbols are used to represent Christianity and other religions.



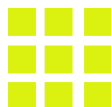
How can you help at home?

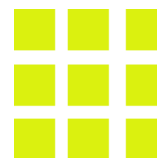

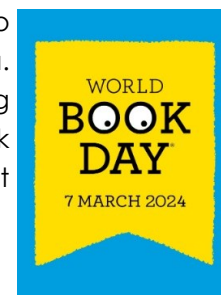

Year 3 - Spring Term 2 2024

Science



In our Science lessons we will continue our learning on plants. The children will develop their learning about flowering plants and water transportation. We will discover the permeability of soil and how the size of a seed relates to the size

of a plant it produces.

We will also be learning about scientist and botanist Joseph Carver Banks to create a fact file and it would be great if the children want to do some home research to support this learning.



Art



In Art this half term we are focusing on two artists and their emotive work, Frank Bramley and Walter Langley. In particular we will closely look at the piece 'A Hopeless Dawn' which shows the scene on the morning after a shipwreck.

The two art skills that we will develop through examining the work of these artists are collage and print.
