
Year 4 Roman Villa Trip





Student improvement

See how much students at Nine Acres Primary School are improving, by comparing their first attempt at an activity to their latest attempt.



On average, students improved by 13% last term.

Success and awards

Students achieving more than 1,000 points in a single week receive an award certificate. Certificates are continuous records of achievement which are based on a bronze, silver and gold scale.



That's a total of 76 certificates awarded to your students last term.

We would like to encourage more children to participate in these interactive mathematical learning sessions. These activities take around 10 minutes each to complete and vary in subject from addition, subtraction, shape and percentages.
