

## Dear Families of Nine Acres Primary School,

As this week is 'Mental Health Awareness Week' we were delighted to finally announce the arrival of our two school based Mental Health Workers; Bea and Aaron. We are so privileged to have been chosen to pilot this project. The Mental Health Support Team (MHST) is a newly established service offering evidenced based interventions in the treatment of mild to moderate mental health conditions. The MHST on the Isle of Wight is a multi-agency collaborative formed of the IW Youth Trust, Barnardo's and the IW NHS Trust. They are currently in the pilot year of service development and initially working in only 8 schools. NINE ACRES IS ONE! Our trainee Educational Mental Health Practitioners (EMHP) will be working at Nine Acres to support our children and staff. They will work under close supervision of highly experienced clinical staff. They will provide Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) based interventions working individually with a young person or working in collaboration with parent or carer where this is appropriate. **#forwardthinking**



As restrictions begin to lift we are now able to get the children out and about a bit more and this started with Year 4's trip to Parkhurst Forest! They had a wonderful time outside exploring the forest, using their teamwork skills and taking risks all under the guidance of Geoff from Wood to Learn Forest School! We continue to look for further opportunities for all our children to get out and about safely and I know Year 6 are very much looking forward to their trip to Chessington World of Adventures later in June.



It would have been Year 6 SATs week this week! We have kept the week as normal and will run our assessment week later in June including the famous bacon sandwiches so they don't miss out! The Year 6 team are already talking to the children's secondary schools and transferring information about them to ensure that they have everything they need to help the children settle into their next stage of their educational journey.

Hopefully, as the weather is warming up, please can I remind families to ensure their child has a named water bottle in school with fresh water daily. The children are so busy throughout the day they certainly need a drink!

Finally, Happy Eid celebrations to our families who observe this festival!!
