As part of our commitment to developing our staffing team Mrs K Smith (Y2 LSA) has attended a Maths conference in Southampton and Mrs Sibbick (Y5 LSA) has attended an English course led by the Local Authority. Miss Rowe and Mrs Michelmore (Y6 LSA's) have also attended Local Authority training linked to supporting pupils with KS2 SATS. In addition Mrs Hewison (Y1 LSA) visited another primary school to see best practice and Mrs Palmer (Y3 LSA) continues to attend her course on supporting pupils' communication skills. Mrs Frampton (Y2 LSA) has hosted a visit from another LSA colleague from another school to see her phonics and share her best practice and Miss Wiltshire (EYFS LSA) and Miss Winter (Y5 LSA) will be attending their ELSA network meetings so they can continue to support pupils' emotional needs. 



ParentPay is our only method of making payments to school.


We no longer accept cash at the office. All items that require payment will be available on ParentPay for example:
