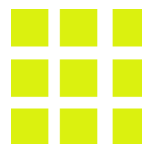

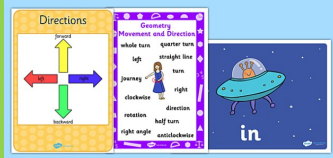
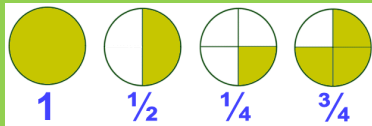
Year 1 - Summer 2 2019 Theme - London



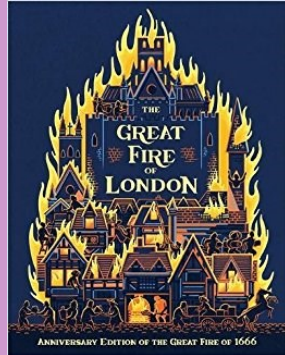
Mathematics

We will start the term by recapping fractions with a focus on halves and quarters. Then we will be looking at position and direction, learning about half and quarter turns.

We will look at the properties of 3D shapes and place value for numbers 50-100. All of these valuable skills will really help us when out shopping and finding our way around as we travel.

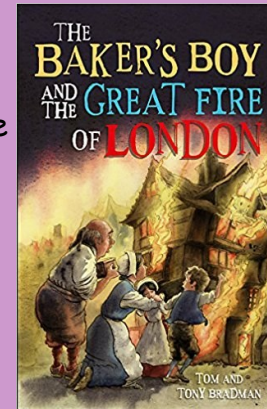


English



This term we will be going back in time to the Great Fire of London, we will be exploring the days the fire occurred and considering the people who experienced the fire.

The class will have the chance to build their own houses at home to recreate Pudding Lane (where the fire started) in school. We will then get to see what actually happened when the fire took hold.



Science

How many materials can we spot at home?

In Science we will be looking at Everyday Materials. We will be investigating objects and identifying the materials that they are made from, including wood, plastic, glass, metal and rock. We will also be considering their simple properties (hard/ soft, shiny/ dull, rough/ smooth).
