We started our week with some amazing news! We have been awarded the 'British Council Award for Internationalism'. Here is what the assessor had to say:

"Nine Acres Primary has successfully met the criteria for the Intermediate level of the International School Award. You have allowed many of your pupils to communicate with their peers in two partner schools in Germany, through which they will learn about Germany and its culture. However the opportunity to learn and practice a new language is excellent and one hopes that this will encourage the pupils to continue to learn new languages in the future.
