As we begin this new school year together, I want to take this opportunity to continue to ask for your parental support with your child's Attendance and Reading. We know that when children have odd days off or time away from school they miss so much both academically and socially and this results in them not feeling as successful as they should and can lead to further unnecessary absences. We do not want this for our Nine Acres children. Of course children may be poorly on occasions but we ask that you consider being absent from Nine Acres as the last resort. We miss your child when they are not with us and we know they don't want to miss out on all the opportunities we have on offer to them!

In addition I can not emphasise enough the importance of supporting your child's reading. This is a life skill and yet we have children in our school who have never shared a book or story with a family member. We make the commitment to you that we will hear your child read, we will teach them to read, we will help them to find books and stories they enjoy and we will dedicate our time to them but we cannot do this without you! We ask that you hear your child read at least 3 times a week and log this on Boom Reader. It can change your child's future! #Togetherforthechildren

Thank you to all our families for supporting us with uniform expectations. We know there has been a slight delay with suppliers. Our children are proud to belong to their school so having the correct uniform and PE uniform makes a difference to them. We continue to welcome any donations of logo items to support our second hand sales and for families in need. Just a polite reminder that children should not have dyed or extreme patterned/shaved hair cuts in term times as these are distracting to themselves and others and takes away from the exemplary role models we ask our children to be to others and our community.
