

**Dear Families,**

Our focus this week has been on continuing our learning about how we can play a part in keeping our children safe.

This week your child may have said they had a different teacher on Tuesday or Wednesday. This is so the whole staffing team could undertake Safeguarding Training. **"Safeguarding refers to the process of protecting children (and adults) to provide safe and effective care. This includes all procedures designed to prevent harm to a child"**.

It is a statutory requirement but most importantly ensures we are up to date with all the latest guidance on how we can help keep the children safe. As a member of our community and a member of the public if you are concerned about a child then you can call Children's Services on **0300 300 0117**

Also this week, the EYFS children were taught about keeping themselves safe using the PANTS rule. This guidance from the NSPCC helps the children understand what isn't acceptable when it comes to their bodies. Of course this isn't just for children in EYFS and it would be great for all our families to remind our children of the rule. 
