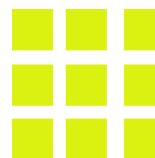

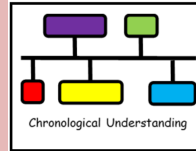


Year 1 - Autumn Term 2 2023 - Technology

- One of the first public telephone boxes was called K1 and one can be found in Bembridge on the Isle of Wight!
- In 1985, the first mobile phone for personal use was used in the UK.
- Telephones in the past were not as small as we have today and many children your age did not have a mobile phone.
