Important facts to know by the end of this topic:


- Rubbish can be found on land, at sea and even in space!

Spoilt - to damage or ruin; make unable to be used or enjoyed.


Trash - anything that is thrown away because it is not wanted or is considered worthless; garbage; rubbish.
