A reminder that school will close early on Friday 25th July at 1.00pm for Years 1-6 and 1.15pm for Year 7.

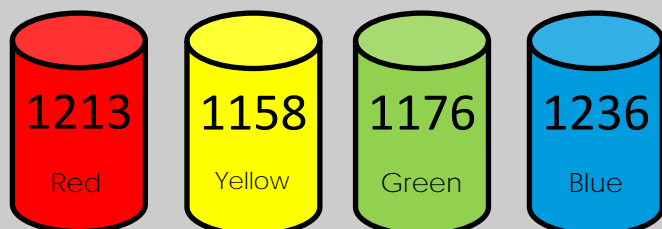

Water Bottles, Suncream & Sun Hats!

We ask that only water is supplied on a day to day basis in your child's water bottle. This is the healthiest option.



However, we also know that children need to stay hydrated to learn! If your child refuses water, in agreement with your child's class teacher only, they may have very, very diluted squash or flavoured water to avoid any medical concerns, however we ask that families take responsibility in ensuring good dental hygiene is in place for their child along with a continued approach to encourage drinking water.

As the warmer weather continues, please ensure your child arrives to school with sun cream already applied and brings a sun hat and is dressed appropriately for the warmer weather conditions.

required to collect.*

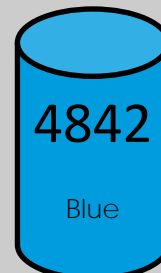
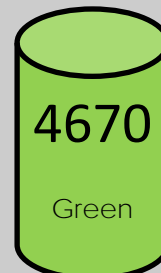
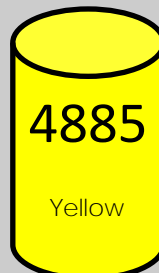
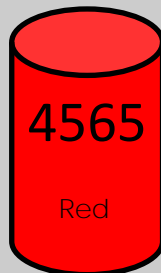
