



World Diabetes Day - 14th November

World Diabetes Day happens on the 14th November every year, all around the world. Diabetes is a long-term condition where blood glucose levels become too high due to a lack of insulin or ineffective insulin. Insulin is the hormone that allows glucose to move from the bloodstream into cells to be used for energy.

There are 2 main types of diabetes: Type 1, where the body cannot produce insulin at all, and Type 2, where insulin production is low or does not work properly.

Families are urged to be mindful of the 4 Ts; toilet, thirsty, tired and thinner. All of which are key symptoms/signs of diabetes.


