Swimming and water safety at Nine Acres Primary School

KS2 Children are provided with weekly swimming lessons for the whole of the summer term by a qualified swimming instructor. The instructor monitors and assesses the children's progress and reports on the following National Curriculum outcomes:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
 - perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

As a school, we monitor this closely and liaise with the instructor about which children by the **end of Year Six** can complete these three key aspects.

The outcomes for the academic year 2020-21 are as follows:
