



Dear Families,

It has been another busy week full of exciting learning opportunities and experiences!

Year 3 embarked on a fantastic adventure to the Novium Museum in Chichester. The children experienced an overnight stay amongst the artefacts and carried out a late night hunt with torches, exploring all of the wonderful items in the Museum. I was honoured to hear that members of the public had commented more than once on how brilliant our children are. One comment came from a passenger on the boat who said "I have never seen children behave so wonderfully on the boat, and I travel a lot!" Well done Year 3!

Our pupil leaders met with our Chair of Governors this week to discuss how, as a leadership team, they have supported the school with different projects. So far this year the team have raised £314.00 for the poppy appeal, attended parents' evening and made lots of cups of tea and coffee and decorated Christmas baubles for the tree in St Thomas' Square. This term, they are trying to make connections with Age UK in order to do some community projects! Watch this space for more information soon.



Year 6 have started their weekly ukulele sessions and are working hard on playing together as a group.

Year 5 continue to work hard on refining their Junior Rock performance. This will be amazing to see on a big stage! I can't wait for the event on the 1st March.

Year 3 drummed their way through Thursday afternoon and learned how to create a rhythm.

Year 2 explored how to make different notes within their recorder sessions.

Year 1 have focused on choosing music for their 'Be our Guest' Ball.

EYFS have been using their stage and practising their drama skills using different sounds.

Year 4 have also been developing their skills with their bodies instead of musical Instruments. Thursday afternoons our Year 4 pupils work together to learn the correct method of playing team games such as football and cricket. I am really proud of all of Year 4 for working together as a team, making sure all children are seen as equal and encouraging each other. Well done Year 4!

Year 6 had the opportunity to experience an aspect of secondary school life today. All of our children went to Medina College and were challenged to take part in either a design technology or trampolining session. We feel it is vitally important to support our oldest pupils and have a positive transition into secondary school. Having opportunities to visit different schools means that our children get to see what life is like beyond primary school.

It was commented by some of the Medina College staff that our children "were fantastic role models for Nine Acres, showing outstanding behaviour and a pride for their school". This is amazing, well done Year 6.

Did you know? If you are in receipt of any of the following support payments, your child may be entitled to receive free school meals:

- Income Support
- Employment Support Allowance
- Income Based jobseekers Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum act 1999
- Guaranteed State pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (providing you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.

Please complete a free school meal application form at the office and we will forward it on your behalf for authorisation.

Gardening club reminder - Please ensure your child has a change of clothes for this club as they will be painting during this half term.


