Year 4 - Spring Term 2 2024

Science

In Science this half term children will be taught about the digestive system and the purpose of our teeth.



By the end of the half term, they will be able to:

- Name and describe the simple functions of the digestive system in humans.
- Describe the journey of food through the digestive system.
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
- Describe what damages teeth and how to look after them.
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.


alongside the work of Rae Smith.

Our English this half term! This term's exciting book!!

This half term we are studying the wonderful fantasy story of The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe. Children will write a narrative in which they create their own, alternative setting for Narnia, and also create a different Mr. Tumnus! After this, they will write a recount in the form of a memoir from a chosen character's point of view. They will learn and apply new and existing skills such as using fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, similes and experiment with new sentence structures, such as applying repetition in a sentence or starting with certain words.



Our Maths this half term!

This half term children will be building on their previously gained knowledge of times tables facts to calculate length and perimeter, then to work with fractions. This will



link to decimal numbers and money, so it's essential that children learn their times tables by heart.
