PE UNIFORM REMINDER

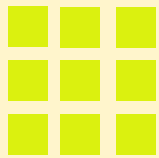
When you chose Nine Acres Primary for your child you also chose to adhere to the Nine Acres Uniform Policy including PE.

Therefore, a reminder:

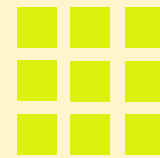
- All children must wear the Nine Acres PE top.

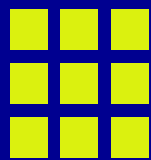

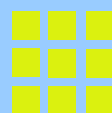
