Dates for your calendar from Helping Hands (Nine Acres Parent Teacher Association)

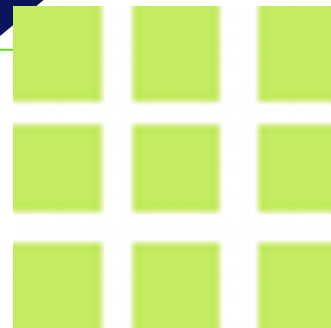
