Dear Families of Nine Acres Primary School,

By now you will have received all the details for our transition next week when your child moves to their next year group. On Monday your child will come home with their meet the teacher/LSA team leaflet that tells you a little bit about our incredible staffing team and who will be teaching them next year.



As you are aware we have had a positive case of Covid19 at Nine Acres Primary School this week resulting in classes being closed for self isolation. I am pleased to say that everyone is well and I'm sure you will join me in wishing them a quick recovery.

Thank you for your understanding surrounding Sports Days and having to postpone at such short notice. We will review the events and reschedule a new date soon.

I must, once again, remind families that if someone in the household has symptoms they should self isolate along with the rest of the household and get a PCR test immediately. Please do not send your child into school during this time whilst the family member has symptoms and is testing. This will help us to avoid transmission within our community and also avoid the impact of having to close classes and move to online learning for the children, as well as the impact on families having to provide childcare.

In addition, I urge all parents to remember to socially distance on the playground and not mix households whilst waiting for your child, continue to wear a mask when on site (unless an exemption lanyard is worn) and continue to follow Government guidance of; hands, face, space.
