Year 2 Knowledge Organiser - Spring Term 1 2025

<u>Science</u>

In Science we are learning about plants and how to care for those in our garden and in the wild.

We will be looking at some key significant Scientists who impact both the island and the UK.

We will even be conducting our own experiment to find our where cress would grow best - indoors our outdoors?



Geography

Our Geography continues from last half term, finding out how our
