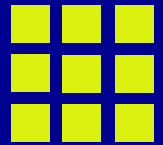

Dear Families of Nine Acres Primary School,

Sadly with the Prime Minister's latest announcement we will not be able to have Parents/Carers at our Sports Days on 1st and 2nd July. I know this is frustrating but we need to ensure the safety of everybody as much as possible. Thank you for your support in this challenging time. The children will enjoy the event with their friends and our photographer will be in for both days to capture the event with photographs available to purchase on his website. A link and details will be sent to families.

A reminder that next Monday 21st is our Development Day. A letter detailing all our transition arrangements from Monday 5th July will be coming out to families shortly. As in previous years, we will be moving the children to their new year groups from 5th July onwards.

Our current Year 6 children will become the new Year 7 classes and will work on transition activities to support their move to Secondary School. This has proven very successful in the past and allows the children to settle quickly, relationships between teachers and children to build and children to feel confident moving forwards. We are also aiming to hold our traditional 'Parents' Meet and Greet' after school on Wednesday 14th July giving you an opportunity to put a face to a name and chat about the learning for that year ahead with your child's new teacher.

Last half term, we conducted our Annual Parental Survey. As promised in this newsletter is the shared feedback. In total 127 Parents' took part in the survey, 36% of our school community. I am delighted to say that over 92% of families would recommend Nine Acres Primary School to another family. THANK YOU! Once again this week we have shown several new families around this week who are excited to join our community and are super impressed by the Nine Acres children, their dedication to their learning, engagement, behaviour and the opportunities offered to our children. Word of Mouth is the best publicity for a school!
