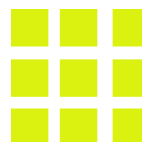

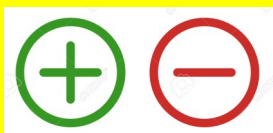

Year 1 - Autumn Term 2 2018 - Around the World



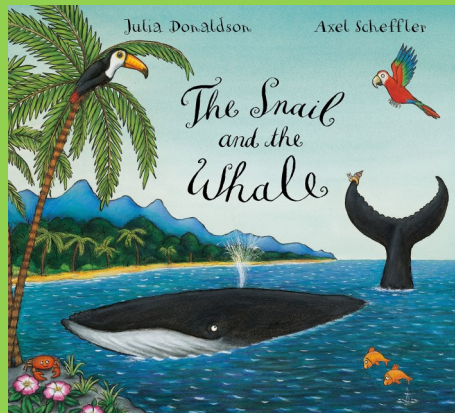
Mathematics

We will be continuing our addition learning this term, looking closely at number bonds to 10. Children should be able to recall these quickly. Then we will be moving onto subtraction of one-digit numbers using a range of concrete, pictorial and abstract methods.



English

Our book for this term is 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson. A whale has suddenly appeared in our classroom the children and they will be predicting why the whale is here. We will be learning to write a fact file for a whale, write a postcard, write a diary and re-write the end of a story. They will be using skills such as applying adjectives, using capital letters for days of the week, using 'and' to extend their sentences, and using question marks.



Science

In Science we will be looking at Seasonal Changes. We will be recording the weather and studying the changes in the length of the day, during the different seasons. We will also be putting on our wellies to observe first-hand the impact of these changes on the world around us, particularly in our school grounds.



Religious Education

This term we will be looking at the Nativity story in the lead up to Christmas, linking this to journeys that people make.

Other Curriculum Areas

In topic we will be looking at what it is like to live in hot and cold places around the world.
