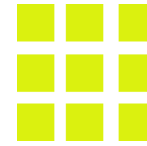

The UK is made up of England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales.

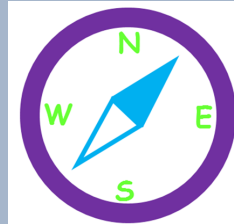
The weather in England can differ from raining to sunshine even in the Summer!

Weather - The state of the atmosphere at a particular place and time as regards heat, cloudiness, dryness, sunshine, wind, rain, etc.

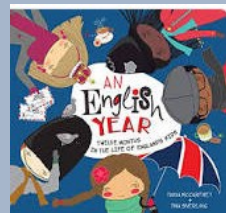
Queen - The female ruler of an independent state, especially one who inherits the position by right of birth.
