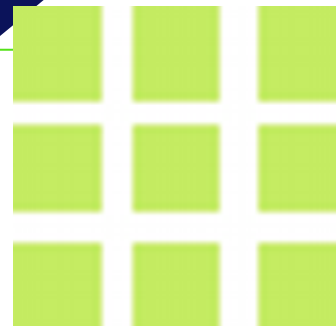
### HELPING HANDS HALLOWEEN PUMPKIN COMPETITION FRIDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2025
