

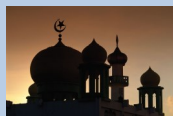
Our PE this Half Term

Our Religious Education and World Views this Half Term

This half term we will be exploring 'sacred places' with a particular focus on Islam and mosques. The children will look into what a mosque is like and what routines are put in place for Muslims that worship there.



How can you help at home?

Reading - Reading unlocks everything around your children - it is so important that children have an understanding of what they have read as well as being able to read individual words. To support, try asking your child to summarise what they have read independently. Our expectation is that pupils are to read at home at least three times a week and that these reads are recorded on the Go Read app.

Maths - Race your child to see who can answer multiplication facts quickest or try using problem solving questions to do with money (when shopping) or measurements (when cooking).

Writing - Ask your children the skills that they have been developing in Speedy SPaG (our daily routine) and encourage them to apply these in their English homework.

Homework - Homework will be set on a Tuesday and due in the following Tuesday. As always, best presentation is expected.

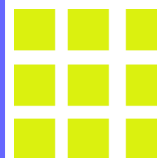

It is believed that the 12 most powerful gods lived on Mount Olympus.







