# Year 3 - Spring Term 2019 - Theme: Scrumdiddlyumptious

## **English**

Who loves chocolate! This term we will be creating exciting writing from our class book, Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl. We will be using the text to create persuasive adverts about some new exciting products. Watch this space for some weird and wonderful items! We will also be developing our vocabulary through character and setting descriptions. We are also going to let our imaginations run wild by creating our own wonderful imaginative stories about food!

#### Science

How do we stand up tall and stay fit and healthy? In science we will be looking at animals including humans and investigating skeletons and muscles, finding out why different parts of our bodies have special functions. We will be exploring nutrition, comparing and contrasting different types of diets and different food groups and how all of these things help to keep us healthy.

## How can you help at home?

Children by the end of Year 4 should know all of their times tables and be able to recall them quickly. This really helps with all other aspects of mathematics!

Practise weekly spellings that are sent home on a Monday. These will be checked and new ones issued the following Monday.

Daily reading (children are encouraged to change their books when they need to).

### **Mathematics**

We are getting fired up to measure everything! We will be exploring:

Measuring the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes

Adding & subtracting amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p. Please help us when you are out shopping with this skill!

Measuring, comparing, adding & subtracting mass (kg/g), volume and capacity (ml/l) What will we find that is heavy??

Working out what time it is. This will really help us to be organised in the morning and to go to bed on time!

We will also be figuring out the number of seconds in a minute, year and leap year. This means we will know how long it is until next

Christmas!

### **Theme**

#### Scrumdiddlyumptious

Have you ever been persuaded to buy something just by looking at the packet it is in? We will be analyzing packaging, looking at the advertising techniques used in order and we will use this to create our own exciting products. Research will be a focus for us, where we will find out about the journey taken by a cocoa bean from it's country of origin to our chocolate bars!. In Art we will be observing and drawing different fruits and vegetables, looking carefully at colour and their fascinating textures

We will also be creating amazing pieces of music, using extracts from Charlie and the Chocolate Factory! I wonder what weird and wonderful sounds we will create!

#### The Night at the Museum!

On Thursday 28th February we will be staying overnight at the Novium Museum in Chichester, where we will be uncovering artefacts, going on a treasure hunt and taking part in lots of different workshops. We will of course spend the evening above the Roman Bath house, discussing all we have learned from the Museum in our sleeping bags!
