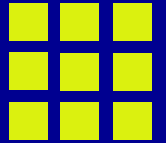

Dear Families of Nine Acres,

I can hardly believe we are just one week away from half term! As time flies, I'd like to take this opportunity to share our school development priorities for 2024/2025 as we reflect on the first half of this term.

Our first priority is our pupils. We are committed to ensuring they receive the best possible learning experiences and opportunities. This year, we will be focusing on securing strong outcomes in Reading, Writing, and Mathematics while fostering a deeper love for Computing and Music. These subjects are essential to building well-rounded learners, and we are excited about the journey ahead.



Secondly, spelling will be a key area of focus. Many of our children are struggling to spell common words, which is preventing them from reaching their full potential as writers. By improving spelling instruction, we aim to support our pupils in becoming more confident and capable writers. Thank you for continuing to support this at home.

Thirdly, attendance and punctuality are of utmost importance. In line with statutory guidance, our whole-school attendance target is set at 97%, but we are currently falling short. Every day in school matters - missing just one or two days can result in gaps in learning, causing your child to fall behind. Please remember that term-time holidays are unauthorised and could lead to further action. Let's work together to make sure every child gets the most out of their education.



Next week, we kick off our Design and Technology Week with an exciting focus on mechanisms. We are delighted to welcome the RNLI (Royal National Lifeboat Institution) as our inspiration for the week, and we will also be holding a Mufti Day on Wednesday 16th October to raise funds for this wonderful charity.



Finally, don't forget about the Pumpkin Parade on Friday! We can't wait to see all the creative designs!
