Another busy and practical week at Nine Acres!

The children have enjoyed their 'Hands On Science' sessions. This has included fireworks, candle making and looking at the digestive system. We are hoping they came home talking all about it!

Year 4 continued their Science theme with a special set up 'Space Camp' on Thursday night, they star gazed and slept in special tents in the hall. We were the first Island school to take up this challenge – and the children loved it.

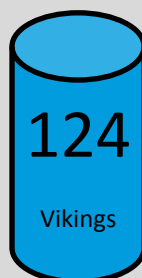
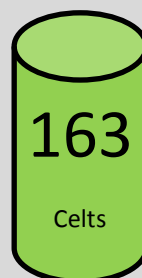
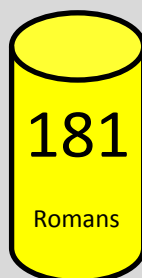
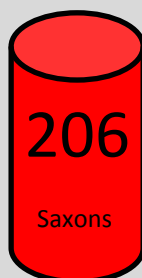


THANK YOU

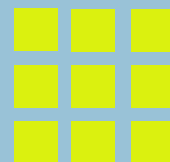
