Dear Families of Nine Acres Primary,

On Wednesday morning we were surprised to have found a very special heartfelt gift at the main entrance. A mystery person delivered a beautiful bouquet of chocolates for all the staffing team to enjoy! What a lovely gesture - the team have thoroughly enjoyed this boost. Thank you to whoever you are!

I can't quite believe we are at half term already and as a team we are beginning to think about the next steps for the school and potential return of our pupils once the Government has made their announcements. Therefore, after half term, those children accessing the school provision will be back into their class groups rather than year groups with the exception of EYFS, Year 2 and Year 6. This is to continue to limit numbers, provide space for our children and adults along with



tailoring teaching support. The children will be taught by an adult in their year team including their class teacher for the majority of the time throughout the week. The Google Meets 'writing workshops' will still take place for those children accessing learning at home (a text with timings will be sent to you) and the new home learning packs are due to be available to families on 25th/26th February.




To add to this, the school will be having a **Development Day on Monday 1st March**. This means the school will be closed to all pupils including key workers and supported families. This is so we can start looking closely at our curriculum both remote and in school and review what we need to change or develop to ensure that when the children do return safely we can close any learning gaps for them and make sure they complete all learning that is needed for their curriculum year.



We are currently finalising our plans for celebrating World Book Day 2021 on the 4th March. We know the day needs to look slightly different this year but Mrs Tingle, our English Leader, is very busy behind the scenes. We will not be having a dress up theme this year as a school because we know that for some families, in lockdown, items are not as accessible to us all. We will have lots of other special events planned throughout the day so all our children can celebrate their love of reading and books.

I would like to **THANK YOU** for all you are doing to work alongside us in supporting your child not just with their learning but also their wellbeing. Thank you to the incredible staffing team of Nine Acres who have once again been phenomenal in going over and above in their support for one another and each child and family in certainly very challenging times - whether that has been tailoring learning to individuals, overcoming being camera shy, daily calls to families, one to one listening to reading over video calls, delivering food parcels to families in need and making a few doorstep check ins to see how everyone is. We are so lucky that Nine Acres is full of such wonderful examples of humanity.
