Dear Families of Nine Acres.

This week we welcomed authors and story tellers; Nicholas Allan, Jack Challoner and a performance from Pippi Longstocking to Nine Acres as part of the IW Literary Festival. What a privilege to be inspired by real life authors!

Today, we also held our Nine Acres 'Pop Up Poetry' event to mark National Poetry Day. The children could choose a poetry session led by different adults across the school. The children loved venturing round the school, spending time with some of their previous teachers, support staff, siblings and different ages as well joining in with familiar poems. It just reminded us of how important those relationships between our children and adults are and for our children they sat, listened, reminisced and huddled together to enjoy a poem or two.

On the theme of Literacy, I am delighted to see so many of our families purchasing the new reading rulers for home reading. Thank you for your wonderful support. Let us know how you get on or if you need any advice in using them. The children are keen to use them and have told us they make a difference! We have placed an order for more stock which will be coming soon!

On Wednesday evening, the Governing Body met to review the Head of School applications from our Year 6 pupils. We had over 20 applications and this is what the Governors wished to share "....

It was wonderful to see that so many pupils wanted to be 'Head of School', made the effort to write an application, and got someone to provide a reference. A panel of School Governors read every single one of the twenty-eight applications and thought carefully about how the applicants would approach the role.

We were delighted by the passion shown in what they wrote and their obvious love of learning at Nine Acres. The applications showed how deeply our School Values are embedded in the way pupils look at the world and work within the school. Some were exceptional, showing ability far above what we would have expected, but the final recommendation to Mrs Dyer was based on how well the applicants persuaded us that they would become a great Head of School, be a role model for others and an ambassador for the school.

Congratulations to Heart who was appointed Head of School, and Jayden and Devlin who were appointed the Deputy Heads of School. The children will take up their posts and begin their duties straight after Half Term.

Finally, some reminders, well opportunities really.... 


