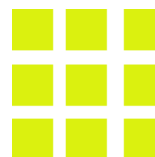

Science

In Music we will be studying how to be music producers!

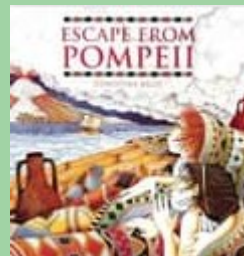
We are going to explore a variety of genres of music and identify their special features. We will then use the Garageband app to write our own song and lyrics to accompany it!
