Year 2 Trip to Roald Dahl Museum and Story Centre – Thursday 6th June 2019

To enhance our learning next term, we would like to inform you that on Thursday 6th June, we have an exciting opportunity to take the Year 2 children to Bucks County Museum & Roald Dahl Children's Gallery in Aylesbury and to visit his village, Great Missenden. During our trip the children will have a tour around the museum in Aylesbury, take part in a workshop and also go on a walking trail around the village to learn how Roald Dahl incorporated his surroundings in some of his books.

We have managed to keep the cost of this trip to a minimum and we are asking for a £15.00 contribution per child, and this is now available to pay on ParentPay.

Please ensure children:

- Wear their school uniform
- Sensible black shoes
- Bring with them a packed lunch and tea in a rucksack (no nuts or sweets please)

(children may have a packed LUNCH provided by the school kitchen but must complete the attached form to order one)

- Bring plenty of water (no fizzy drinks please) and snacks for the ferry (a fruit snack will be provided)
- Bring a waterproof jacket
- Have their up to date inhalers with them

Children will not need to bring any electronic devices or any money as there is no opportunity to visit any gift shops during our visit. Children will be allowed to bring a <u>disposable camera</u>, (not digital) with them to take pictures of their day. Please ensure all cameras are clearly named.
