Dear Families of Nine Acres,

We started on Monday with our European Languages Day which resulted in each class taking up a focused country study, they researched facts, tried authentic food, spoke some key words and talked about cultures and traditions within the country. It was

a really exciting day and I know many of our children now want to go abroad and visit their chosen country! I hope they told you all about it at home and if they wish to bring in any further study please let me know!



I would like to remind families of the importance of 'Attendance'. Being in school on time everyday. We know that sometimes morning routines can go wrong. It's ok! It's normal! But we need to work

together to get our children to school every day and on time. Every minute counts and some children are missing out just from being 5/10 minutes late each day.

In addition, we also know that, especially at this time of year, there are coughs and colds. You



are their parent, you know them well but we will always ring you if they are feeling poorly in school and are happy to liaise with you should they need some medication. We are already seeing some of our children having several days off and this means they are missing their learning, friendships and experiences we offer at Nine Acres. After missing a few days we often find the child struggles to catch up on what they are studying and fit in socially with their peers, this is when anxiety creeps in. We look closely at patterns of attendance e.g. is it Mondays? Is it PE days? and will be writing a letter to those families whose child's attendance is dropping below 95% to see what we as a team together with you can do to improve the **situation all for your child's future success.**

If you want to discuss attendance with us please make an appointment to chat with Mr Thomas. We offer so much at Nine Acres Primary and your child deserves over and above a 'normal' school experience so lets make everyday count.

MEDICATION

WHILST IN SCHOOL

Parents/Carers who wish prescribed medicines to be administered to their child at Nine Acres must fill in the appropriate permission form at the school office. Medicines or tablets should be given to Mrs Smith, Mrs Barnes or Mrs Chandler at the school office where they are kept in the locked medical cabinet.

Only prescribed medicines in the original containers can be administered. These will not be accepted if they are not in an original container.

Dose and time to administer medicines must match the printed pharmaceutical label from your doctor. However, if your child is well enough to be in school, and just requires a dose of Calpol during the school day, you are more than welcome to come into school to administer this yourself.
