# Year 4 Knowledge Organiser - Summer Term 1 2025

### Science

Throughout this half term, the children will be continuing to develop their knowledge of animals including humans by conducting experiments to determine what types of liquids are good for our teeth.



The children will then be learning about how energy is passed on through food chains and the



classification of animals.

# **History**

## How did the Roman Empire impact Britain?

This unit looks at the Romans and their achievements from 43 CE to 410 CE. We'll study what early Rome was like, how the empire became, the Roman invasion of Britain and the unit finishes with a study of the final years of the Roman Empire.



# Art

This term, Year 4 will be exploring the work of 18th century artist, Sarah Biffin, before using a wide variety of media to observe from both primary and secondary sources. Children will then use these observations to create small scale sculptures of birds, using armatures to support their models.



## Our English this half term!

We are going to study Michael Morpurgo's Kensuke's Kingdom, a MICHAELMORPURGO fantastic adventure story full of twists and turns and surprises! Through this story children will write in the genres of recounts and explanations in areat detail.

## Our Maths this half term!

Children are going to build on their knowledge of times tables and fractions when studying decimals further, which will be followed by studying money, time and shape. You can help by ensuring you have coins and
