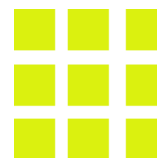

Year 1 - Spring Term 2 2024

Science

We are continuing to explore plants this half term as different plant life starts to bloom around the school.

We will be looking at plants more in depth and studying the structure of plants. We will also be sorting wild and garden plants - don't forget to look out for these at home and when you are out and about!

We will research Anna Atkins and will be creating our own cyanotypes in Art!



Geography

This half term we will be carrying out fieldwork at our local park and around our school environment.

We will use different maps and plan our route to the park. We will collect data on the facilities at the park and think about how we could improve it.

When exploring our school environment, we will be collecting data on where we find plant life and think about how we can encourage more plant life around school.



Music

Our theme for Music this half term is Space!

We will be listening to 'Mars' from The Planet Suites and discussing how it makes us feel.

We will be combining our own simple rhythms to make our own ostinatos.

When listening to music at home, can you answer these questions:

- ◆ If this music was a colour, what would it be?
- ◆ If this music was a shape, what would it be?
- ◆ If this music was a line, what type of line would it be (straight, curly, jagged)?



Our English this half term!
