Dear Parents/ Carers of our wonderful Year 2 children,

Re. Mathematics - Clocks

In Maths in Year 2 we will soon be learning about telling the time on an analogue clock. To give the children a head start in their learning each child will be making and decorating their own clocks ready for their learning and to take home. Parents and Carers are invited to attend on Tuesday 11th February from 1:30pm to help with the making.



We will be sending the children home with their clocks over the holidays and would love it if they could get really involved and active with telling the time in their half term.

Ways you could support your child in learning to tell the time:

- Use their new clocks to ask questions about time.
- Talk about time on the way home (we were walking for 30 minutes, that's half an hour).
- Talk about the hands and what they mean.
(Big hand = minute hand, little hand = hour hand).
- See how many analogue clocks you can spot in a day around town.
- Looking at o'clock times, quarter past and quarter to times then reading time to the nearest five minutes (five past 2 o'clock).

The clocks will need to be bought back on Monday 24th February ready to show off their new knowledge and use their clock in their learning.
