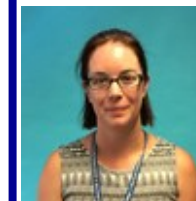

## Important facts to know by the end of this topic:

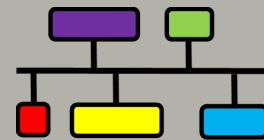
Dinosaurs lived and became extinct a long time ago.

Most dinosaurs who roamed the Isle of Wight lived on the beaches.

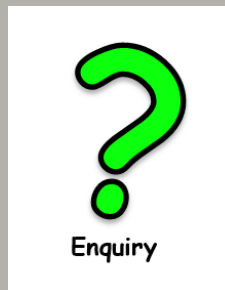
Dinosaurs were on the Isle of Wight during the cretaceous period.

## Key Skills



Chronological Understanding

We will be introducing the children to timelines and exploring what they can tell us about when the dinosaurs lived and when they were on the Isle of Wight.



We will be learning about different dinosaurs and finding out where the dinosaurs lived on the island and what happened to the dinosaurs on the island.

## Key Vocabulary

**History** - the study of past events, particularly in human affairs.

**Old** - belonging to the past; former.

**New** - produced, introduced, or discovered recently or now for the first time; not existing before.

**Object** - a material thing that can be seen and touched.

**Before** - during the period of time preceding a particular event or time

**Time** - the indefinite continued progress of existence and events in the past, present, and future regarded as a whole.

**Past** - gone by in time and no longer existing.
