

As you will be aware, our Year 4 pupils will be completing the Government's statutory Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) in June 2025. This assessment is taken by all Year 4 children in schools across the country and is designed to assess their fluency in times tables up to 12 × 12.

The Year 4 pupils have been working <u>extremely hard</u> to ensure that they are going to be ready and prepared for these assessments and their continued attitude towards their learning is exemplary.


