

What an enjoyable May Fayre last Friday. Thank you to everyone who attended and joined in with the activities on offer. A reminder that this is not a performance but an opportunity for ALL children to stand up in front of an audience and build on their confidence to speak.

SCHOOL DINNER BALANCES




