Year 4 - Autumn Term 1 2024

<u>Science</u>

The children will be buzzing about Science this half term as we explore and learn all about electricity!

First the pupils will learn key knowledge about keeping themselves safe when using electrical devices, moving onto exploring the key symbols and components in order to make working circuits. Using a range of materials the pupils will discover the difference between conductors and

insulators and how changing different variables can affect their circuits.



History - Ancient Greece

This unit looks at the Ancient Greeks and their achievements from around 3000 BCE to the reign of Alexander the Great around 330 BCE.

Through their learning, children will use their skills to find similarities and differences between events, order events in chronological order, use artefacts to make deductions, find out what's changed and what's continued, what caused an event to happen and what was its consequence and their significance.

Children will learn about what the Ancient Greek civilization's achievements were and how they impacted on our lives today.
