- It has at least 6 different climates, which contributes to its diverse flora and fauna
- The Tropic of Capricorn runs across it.
- It is located in the Southern Hemisphere.
- There's a small island off the south coast of Australia called Phillip Island, which has links to the Isle of Wight.

Key Skills

- Locating the tropics on a map.
- Name and locate some of the main islands around Australia.
- To use 6-digit grid reference when using Ordnance Survey maps.
- To describe and explain human and physical features of land.
- To find out about the climate zones in Australia.



Key Vocabulary

Hemisphere - one half of the Earth, especially a half north or south of the equator or west or east of the prime meridian.

Location - the site or position of something.

Longitude - the angular distance east or west of the prime meridian that stretches from the North Pole to the South Pole and passes through Greenwich, England.

Latitude - an imaginary line joining points on Earth's surface that are all of equal distance north or south of the equator.

Ordnance Survey - It carries out the official surveying of GB, providing the most accurate and up-to-date geographic data, relied on by government, business and individuals.

Region - a large land area that has geographical, political, or cultural characteristics that distinguish it from others, whether existing within one country or extending over several.


At home you could: -
