

We started off this week with a special visitor from Hampshire who wanted to find out how we support children with their learning and how we use funding to make sure all children achieve to the best of their ability. He was very impressed with all of the work that our teachers are doing in and out of the classroom to make sure the pupils of Nine Acres are not only progressing in English and Maths, but are learning important life skills! Well done everyone!



As it is Science Week this week, we have had some exciting 'hands on' workshops, where the children could put their practical skills into action. On Thursday, Trevor from Dinosaur Isle came to visit us with a range of fossils that the children could explore and discuss. All children learned lots of new and interesting facts, such as how long it takes to form a fossil, why different fossils appear around the world and the science behind why we actually have fossils!

Throughout today, we have really enjoyed welcoming parents into school who have stepped up to the challenge of creating

the best aeroplane. Children (and parents) had to think about aerodynamics, forces and how to create a fair test in order to compete for the title of "best aeroplane in flight". We even had a parents competition at the end of the day.

We had a practice fire drill this week, where the children were amazing at getting out of the building safely. All of our children were brilliant at explaining why this is important, they were even checking to make sure that their teachers double checked that all children were out and safe.
