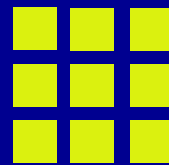

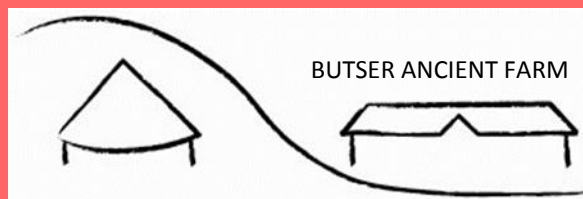

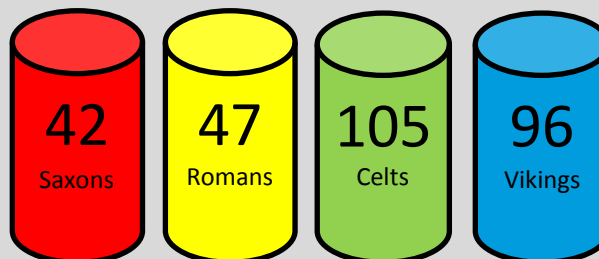
## Dartmouth, Kendal & Warwick Trip to Butser Ancient Farm - Tuesday 31st March
