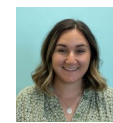

Year 1 Knowledge Organiser - Autumn Term 1 2025

Science

This half term our topic is 'Animals' (including humans). We will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and look at whether all humans have the same body parts.

We will also look at our five senses and how we use them in our everyday lives. During the term we will complete different experiments using our five senses.



History

This half term our topic in History is 'Kings and Queens'. We will investigate which monarchs have reigned over time, including King Charles I, Queen Victoria, Queen Elizabeth II and King Charles III. We will also be learning about castles, including the parts of a castle and how they have changed over time.

The children will have the opportunity to visit Osborne House and see where Queen Victoria lived.

In Music this half term, we are learning to keep the beat, find the pulse and use our bodies to make sounds.
