What is Go Read?

Finally, we have now launched our much-awaited new way for logging your child's reading through the virtual platform of Go Read! The children are super excited to get going so by working together we can make sure your child is a reader for life!

Go Read is a digital platform where you and your child can log their reading and even earn rewards! It is expected that <u>every</u> child reads at least 3 times a week (as a minimum) but we know many of our children read much more than this in a week. The more they read, the more rewards they will receive!



Gems are awarded when you or your child logs their reading and complete book reviews. We are also able to award bonus gems to the children who go 'over and above' in their reading. The class with the most reads in a week receives ERIC (Everybody Reading in Class) and their class will be put forward to spend the money on a class party or trip at the end of the year!

Children can even have fun creating their own Avatar on their account and there will be a prize for the best Avatar! Get creative! There will also be an extra special award for our schools 'Top Reader'

So how do we get started?

This afternoon your child has brought home their Go Read letter where there is a barcode and login details for your child's Go Read account. This login can be used by multiple people that may read

account. This login can be used by multiple people that may read with your child e.g. Grandparents, aunties, uncles and even big brothers - so do get the whole family involved!

In addition, there is a guide on how to download the Go Read parent app to your phone (it's free!) or alternatively there are instructions on how to login using a computer through a simple search on the internet at home. The children tell us that they can also download the app on their Xbox's, PlayStation and other devices so let's go for it!

If your child is in Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 or Year 6 they will also receive a login to use for themselves so that they can log their own independent reading alongside your log in. We feel this will give them a sense of independence and responsibility on their reading journey.

Any questions regarding logging in please speak to our amazing office team. We are more than happy to spend some time with you getting it all set up and ready to go!

Reading really is the key to the children's future success so let's continue to work together by putting just 10 or 15 minutes a day aside for each and every one of them so they can all continue to love READING FOR LIFE!




