On this note, we say a fond farewell to our Year 6 cohort of children who move to their chosen Secondary Schools. I know they will take all their Nine Acres values with them and I can not wait to see them standing proud in their new uniforms and taking every opportunity offered to them with confidence and belief.



As shared in my Ofsted letter, even though the inspector found all areas of Nine Acres exceptional, we will not stand still and next year looks just as exciting. Alongside our everyday practice and core focus, we will be working on:

- Our Music Curriculum offer (any donations of instruments would be welcomed!)
- Our Computing Curriculum offer
- Ensuring that we revisit fluent speaking and listening with our children to support them in their writing and spelling
- Reading in the wider curriculum for knowledge and understanding
- Primary Careers and inspiring our children in their future

One area we would like our community to support us with is our children's attendance. Our Nine Acres Attendance Target is 97% for the academic year and we know many of our children achieve this. However, we still have an issue with children having the odd day off here and there - this adds up! I cannot begin to share with you the detrimental impact this has on your child (the present and the future!) and as a staffing team we see this when the children return to us. Not only do they have to catch up on learning so they do not fall behind but also socially they find it harder. Our Nine Acres children want to be in school and it is really important that, as adults, we must take responsibility for making this happen for them, whatever our own feelings or needs are.

The staffing team at Nine Acres are 'exceptional' they go over and above every day for your child. They continuously seek to ensure that they are up to date with current practice, relentless in all they do and ensure that every child has the opportunity to shine with their own unique gifts and talents. I would once again like to congratulate them on their recognition and successes both locally and nationally. Along with the children and our community, Nine Acres continues to 'Strive for Excellence'.
