

Year 1 - Autumn Term 1 2019 - Our Environment





Mathematics

We will be starting with sorting objects this term. This will lead into counting and finding effective strategies to help us count using objects and pictures. We will be working on ordering numbers 1-100. We will then be focusing on the place value of numbers, breaking them down into tens and ones. This will ensure that we have a secure knowledge of numbers for the rest of the year.



English
